# ADMISSION GUIDE BOOK

## I. Admission Procedure:

### A. Higher Secondary Courses in Arts, Commerce and Science (10+2):

#### Educational Qualification:

Candidates must have passed H.S.L.C. Examination or its equivalent under Government recognized Board. Any break in studies after passing H.S.L.C. or equivalent examination must be supported by a "GAP Certificate" issued as per specified proforma by an appropriate authority.

#### Admission Process:

A candidate interested to take admission in H.S 1st year course for the session 2026-27 shall have to undergo the following process.

i) He/She shall have to apply in the **Darpan** admission portal of the Government of Assam and to select the institution of choice.

ii) Once selected for admission in NC. College, Badarpur in the **Darpan** portal (Darpon Portal) he/she shall have to take online admission by visiting the college website - [nccollege.ac.in](http://nccollege.ac.in) after appearing before the Admission Board and observing all the admission formalities as and when announced by the college.

### B. FYUGP First Semester:

#### Educational Qualification:

Candidates must have passed H.S. Final Examination or its equivalent under Government recognized Board/Council.

#### Admission Process:

A candidate interested to take admission in Four Year Under Graduate Programme (FYUGP) under NEP 2020 for the session 2025-26 shall have to undergo the following process.

i) He/She shall have to appear the Common University Entrance Test (CUET) conducted by the National Testing Agency (NTA) and shall have to submit CUET Marksheet along with H.S/equivalent Marksheet and other required documents.

ii) He/She shall have to apply in the Samarth eGov admission portal (SAMARTH PORTAL) of the Government of Assam.

iii) Candidates interested to take admission in any of the FYUGP 1<sup>st</sup> Semester courses must visit the college website( COLLEGE PORTAL LINK) and submit online admission form uploading the scan copy of the print out copy of Samarth application form along with all the required particulars.

N.B: After completing the 1<sup>st</sup> phase of admission on the basis of merit and other reservation criteria taking into consideration the marks secured in H.S/equivalent examination & CUET, if any seat remains vacant, the college may give admission in the next phases to the candidates without CUET till the availability of seats subject to the approval of higher authorities.

iv) A Candidate can apply for admission into FYUGP 1<sup>st</sup> semester in the following Discipline Specific Core (DSC) Courses :

1. English 2. Bengali 3. Economics 4. Political Science 5. History 6. Arabic 7. Commerce 8. Physics 9. Chemistry 10. Mathematics 11. Botany 12. Zoology 13. Ecology & Environmental Science 14. Information Technology (B.Voc)

N.B: \*The facility of offering FYUG in HONOURS & HONOURS WITH RESEARCH is available in all the courses provided by the college. However, the facility of lateral exit is also available as per NEP 2020 guidelines notified by the Assam University, Silchar.

\*\*Admission in all courses (H.S. & FYUG under NEP 2020) will be made strictly on the basis of merit, availability of seats and concerned guidelines. The College authority reserves the right to accept or reject any application without assigning any reason for the greater interest of the college.
